Spring 2015

- One new school has joined the Partnership, St Edmund's Prep School, as part of the School Games' initiative to involve ALL schools
- All 24 schools have been involved in events in the Autumn and/or Spring Terms
- 2325 participants in festivals and competitions so far
- 383 leaders involved in supporting these activities
- 4 courses so far: KS2 gymnastics, Dance, KS1 PE, Subject Leaders' Training Day plus a whole school gymnastics course still to come
- Teams entered in new county disability events in Boccia and Sportshall
- 21 schools achieved the School Games Mark (formerly known as the Kitemark) with 4 Gold, 10 Silver and 7 Bronze Awards.
- North East Herts named in October in the top 10 Partnerships in the country in terms of engagement and involvement in all the aspects of PE & School Sport in which we are involved.
