### **Shaping the new school: RSAT Parents' Meeting**

This letter is a reminder about the upcoming meeting taking place on 28th September, Greneway School, at 6.30pm, and to explain how it will run.

**Introduction:** As Chair of RSAT, I will briefly outline the proposal sent out in my recent communication and will explain our thinking to date – how and why we have got to this point.

**Main body of the meeting:** The most important part of this meeting will be to listen to what parents like most about our schools at present and what they want RSAT to retain in any new arrangements.

**What happens next?** At this stage, we want to hear your views, so we can be sure we understand what's important to you and the town. After the meeting, we will then prepare a consultation document which will propose a plan for the future of the three schools. We will, of course seek your views on this proposal at that time.

**Who should attend?** We know lots of parents will want to share their thoughts with us, but we are aware that the school hall can only take so many people. In the unlikely event the hall capacity is reached, we're sorry but we may have to ask some people to come back for a second session. *(Parking spaces are limited at Greneway but you are welcome to use Meridian Upper School car park.)*
